To all Head Teachers - Urgent Notice. We at Solihull Police would be very grateful if you could read the following notice out in your school assemblies.

A message from St. Alphege Neighbourhood Team - Solihull Police Station:

It has come to our attention that numerous young people in Solihull are being approached by others and are being asked to hand over money and/or other property and that in some instances intimidating tactics are being employed.

We at Solihull Police are aware that these matters are not being reported officially to us. In order for us to deal with the situation we need people to come forward and tell us about what has happened.

We already have a number of people who are prepared to make a stand against this sort of behaviour. We need more people to come forward.

We understand that this is a difficult thing to do. We are holding a meeting at Solihull Police Station on Saturday 4th February 2012 at 12.00 midday to talk the matter through with parents and young people.
